## **1. Introduction**

The official SHEER website is designed to be a communication tool for project partners and a way to disseminate the activity of the project.

For this reason, two parts of the SHEER website have been defined: first a public domain part and second a password-protected area.

The website has been on line since June 16<sup>th</sup> 2015 and is available at [www.sheerproject.eu](http://www.sheerproject.eu).

The website is based on Joomla, a free and open-source content management system (CMS) and application framework that powers 3% of the entire web.

## 2. SHEER WEBSITE – PUBLIC DOMAIN

As illustrated in Figure 1, there are four main areas in the website:

- a graphic area with logos and the link to the Reserved area;
- the toolbar;
- An area with the scrolling images;
- a short introduction to the project.

In particular, the toolbar area is composed by various public sections containing general information:

- **Objectives.** All the objectives of the project are described;
- **Partnership.** The list of partners involved in the Project is available and links to their websites;
- **Deliverables.** The public deliverables will be made available
- **WP.** The Work Packages of the project are presented;
- **Events.** Meetings and forthcoming events are listed;
- **Dissemination.** Papers, presentations and reports relevant for the project are listed;
- **Links.** Links to other website relevant for the project and other possible links of interest;
- **Contacts.**

### 3. MANAGEMENT SECTION OF THE WEBSITE

The reserved area is subdivided in:

1. **Deliverables.** In this subarea all the final deliverables will be uploaded. Only the Coordinator has the right to upload the deliverables to make sure that only the final version of each deliverable is on the website.
2. **Documents.** All the official documents of the project have been made available.
3. **Project Management Team Meetings.** The agendas and the minutes of the PMT meetings are available in this section
4. **Reports.** In the subarea three sections are available:
  - a. *Official Periodic Reports*, where the reports to the EC will be uploaded
  - b. *6-Month Reports*. According to the procedures, all the partners will be required to report on a 6-monthly basis. The WP Leaders consolidate the information from the partners into 6-monthly WP Reports that will be the base for the monitoring of the project progress by the Project Management Team
